Working experience

Work performance

Represented a U.S.-funded trading company in a sales contract dispute arbitration against a technology company (CIETAC, with English as the arbitration language). Leveraging arbitration proceedings to facilitate settlement, she assisted the client in fully recovering the outstanding principal and accrued interest, followed by a withdrawal of the arbitration claim.

Represented a German logistics company in disputes arising from an international railway through transportation contract and a contract for the carriage of goods, with the disputed amount exceeding CNY 10 million.

Represented a wholly Swiss-owned machine tool company (defendant) in a product liability lawsuit. The case was successfully resolved through mediation, with the client not required to pay any damages.
